God once again proved faithful in blessing 36 youth through the Chrysalis process!

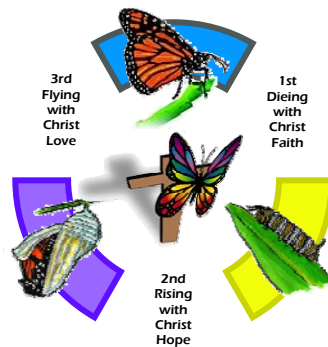

and celebrate communion together.

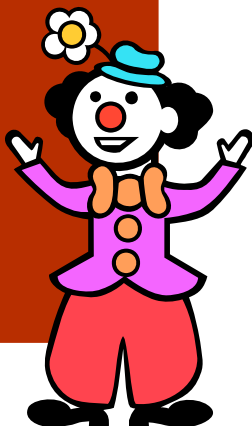
After the service there will be a time of food and fellowship with pizza being brought in from some of Vienna's best pizza places!

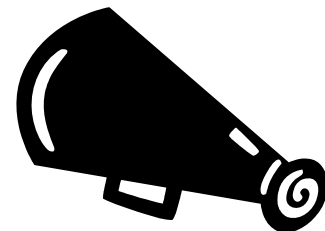
in will conclude at 6:00am.
